- ✓ I will not make derogatory remarks or reference via any media about another member or member's family or friends: this includes making statements about their age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs, sexual identity or appearance.
- ✓ I will show appreciation and respect towards club volunteers including chaperones and committee members.
- ✓ I will appreciate and respect all BISC coaches at all times – this includes group rehearsals for special events.
