Any BISC member not adhering to the above will be disciplined in accordance with Section 9 of the Club's Constitution (Constitution can be viewed on BISC website)

For Skaters:

- ✓ I will respect and support my fellow club members at all times.
- ✓ I will not shout, swear, become violent or use sarcasm.
- ✓ I will endeavour to resolve any conflict(s) I may have with any other club member(s) in a dignified and respectful manner, never resorting to hostile behaviour or violence
- ✓ I will not make derogatory remarks or reference via any media about another member or member's family or friends: this includes making statements about their age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs, sexual identity or appearance.
- ✓ I will show appreciation and respect towards club volunteers including chaperones and committee members.
- ✓ I will appreciate and respect all BISC coaches at all times
 this includes group rehearsals for special events.
- ✓ I confirm I have read and understood the rink patch etiquette code.

For parents:

- ✓ Discourage improper and unfair behaviour setting a good example by your own behaviour at all times.
- ✓ Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.
- ✓ Support your child's involvement but never force them to take part in the sport.

- ✓ Endeavour to resolve any issues or inappropriate behaviour by another club member or between your child and other skaters by reconciliatory means rather than a public reprimand.
- ✓ Do not take disciplinary measures into your own hands any issues/complaints should be made in writing to either JNL rink management or the BISC committee if club related.
- \checkmark Respect the rights of other parents and their children.
- ✓ Be aware that public and personal adverse comments or gossip regarding coaches and rink management can result in disciplinary action being taken by both BISC and JNL.
- ✓ Do not make complaints without good reason. Opportunist, vexatious or malicious complaints will be treated as harassment.
