- 5 Note that free dance classes may be combined according to programme length if there are too few entries.
- 6 Age – under 25 years*.

***No minimum or maximum standard for classes 2 to 11. However, depending on the number of entries and in view of time constraints, the test and age requirements for the British Solo Ice Dance Championships may be taken into account when acceptance of entries is considered for these classes.**

Compulsory dance	1	-	Dance level 2 and under. One dance to be skated: Dutch Waltz. Ask for help if you want to learn this dance!
Compulsory dance (novice)	2	-	One dance to be skated: Golden Skater's Waltz
Compulsory dance (primary)	3	-	One dance to be skated: 14 step
Compulsory dance (junior)	4	-	One dance to be skated: American Waltz
Compulsory dance (intermediate)	5	-	One dance to be skated: Starlight Waltz
Compulsory dance (senior)	6	-	One dance to be skated: Westminster Waltz
Free dance (novice)	7	1.5 mins +/- 5 secs	Free dance programme, vocal music permitted
Free dance (primary)	8	1.5 mins +/- 5 secs	Free dance programme, vocal music permitted
Free dance (junior)	9	2 mins +/- 5 secs	Free dance programme, vocal music permitted
Free dance (intermediate)	10	2 mins +/- 5 secs	Free dance programme, vocal music permitted
Free dance (senior)	11	2 mins +/- 5 secs	Free dance programme, vocal music permitted
Time permitting - Drawn partners	12	-	One dance to be skated – Dutch Waltz all names to be put into a hat and drawn – regardless of boy/girl/coach!!! Fancy dress optional but recommended! Prize for best costume!
