All competitors must be members of Bracknell Ice Skating Club and coached at Bracknell Ice Rink in order to enter club competitions (although they do not need to have used their coach to create their program). Competitors may enter a maximum of one individual class and one group class.

The competition is open to all members whatever age they are.

Classes may be cancelled or combined if there are too few entries

The closing date for entries is **8 am Wednesday 9th February 2011** however in the event of there being too many entries for the time available, entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis. Entries received after the competition is fully allocated and before the closing date will go on a waiting list in case a competitor withdraws.

The draw will be on Saturday 12th February in the café at 8.30 a.m.

The NISA test standard required is the field moves test level held as at the closing date of the competition. Maximum standards also include equivalents * and equivalent dance moves

A competitor may apply to compete in a higher class than their test level allows only if they are officially scheduled to take the relevant test for the next level up after the closing date but on or before the date of competition and if their coach agrees that they may skate in that higher class The application must be made by the closing date.

Maximum standards also include equivalents* and equivalent dance moves.

In any case of uncertainty the decision of the club competition secretary (free skating) is final.

No verbal or late entries will be accepted.

Props can be used but they must be moved and positioned on the ice by the skater(s) in one journey.

No intervention by a 3rd party (not on the ice) such as remote control or throwing on of props

Marks will be awarded for way in which the costume and props are being used more than for the actual costume/props themselves. No fireworks (or similar) are allowed

Each judge will also give a second mark for Entertainment value. In the event of a tie, this mark will be used as the tiebreaker.
